

Home-Based Activity 2 (N2)

Title: Homemade Hand Cleaning Spray

Duration of activity: 15 – 30 mins

Your child will:

- √ Represent ideas through artwork
- √ Show appreciation and care for others
- **What do you need?**
 - Spray bottle
 - Small pocket-sized bottles
 - Salt
 - 120ml water (Preferably
 - Filtered/distilled water)
 - 120ml white vinegar
 - Essential oils - Preferably tea tree oil (Optional)
 - Paper
 - Scissors
 - Coloured pencils
- **Description of activity**

□ Washing hands with soap and water is the best way to remove germs. However, we may not always have access to water and soap! Don't worry, we can always make our hand cleaning solution!

What you can do with your child:

1. Fill the spray bottle with water, white vinegar, a pinch of salt and 10 to 15 drops of essential oil (optional). Shake the bottle until the salt are dissolved.
2. Transfer some of the solution into the small pocket-sized bottles.
3. Discuss with your child to think of a name for the hand cleaning solution and design a label/logo to paste on the bottles.
4. Place the spray bottle filled with hand cleaning solution in common areas such as lift, staircase, etc for everyone use! ☺ Enjoy!
